Observations

Pet Scan(if deemed necessary)

Indicates the presence and location of cancer and metastases.

Lung PA;

Evaluation of the respiratory system

Complete Abdominal Ultrasound

Evaluation of diseases of intra-abdominal organs

Thyroid USG

Ultrasound-guided examination of the thyroid gland

PVR

USG taken after the bladder is emptied is significant in the diagnosis of prostate cancer.

Colonoscopy

Examination of the large intestine and rectum

Pulmonary Function Test

Indicates loss of function in the lung.

Gastroscopy

Examination of esophagus, stomach and 12 intestines

Hemogram

It is the main marker in the treatment of anemia and blood diseases.

Sedimentation

Detection of inflammation and infection in the body

Glucose

Diabetes diagnosis and follow-up

Full Urine

Early diagnosis of kidney and urinary tract diseases

Aspartat transaminaz (AST)

It is a liver function test.

Alanine aminotransferase (ALT)

It is a liver function test.

Gamma-glutamyl transferase (GGT)

It is a liver function test.

Alkaline Phosphatase

Diagnosis of liver, biliary tract, heart and kidney diseases

Urea

It is a kidney function test.

Creatinine

It is a kidney function test.

TSH

Diagnosis and monitoring of goiter disease

Peripheral Spread

It is the gold standard for lymphoma and leucemia.

CRP

It is used in the follow-up of Heart and Infectious Diseases.

HBsAg

Hepatitis B is a marker. It is also important in liver cancers.

Anti HBsAg

Hepatitis B is a marker. It is also important in liver cancers.

HCVAG

Hepatitis-C is a marker. It is also important in liver cancers.

Homocysteine

Cardiovascular Risk Detection

Alfafetoprotein

Indicates liver, testicular and ovarian cancers

CA 19-9

It is important for the follow-up of colorectal cancers and pancreatic cancers.

Erythropoietin

Indicates kidney cancer.

Occult Blood in Stool

Early colon cancer screening and detection of gastrointestinal bleeding

CA 15-3

Determination of breast cancer

CA125

Early signs of ovarian cancer

CYFRA 21-1

Indicates esophageal, lung and bladder cancer.

CA 72-4

Indicates Stomach Cancer.

PSA:

It is decisive for prostate cancer.

LDH

Shows lymphoma and testicular seminoma.
